

This page outlines the steps to configure the Networking feature within the platform. Follow these instructions to enable job-sharing between fleets in the network.

The settings page can be found:

- Using Option+1 and typing “NETWORK SETTINGS”
- Or going to Admin > Config > Settings > Network

1. Enable Networking

To enable the Networking feature, navigate to the **Network Settings** page:

Enabled:

- Toggle this option to “Yes” to activate job sharing with partner fleets in your network.
- Your fleet’s unique identifier (UUID) will be displayed here for reference:
976abcd-2304-437c-8d0f-07d59aeee82d.

2. Automatic Networking

- This setting allows jobs to be automatically shared with the network.
- Default is set to **No** (manual sharing). You can change this to “Yes” if you want jobs to be shared automatically when they meet the configured threshold.

Note: Even with automatic networking enabled, jobs can still be manually added to the network at any time.

3. Manage Partner Fleets

The List of Fleets section displays all fleets available in the network. Here, you can configure which fleets your fleet shares jobs with.

Fleet Name and Details:

- For each fleet, you’ll see the fleet’s name, address, phone number, and their unique network UUID.

Example:

Bailey Cabs - Steven

- Address: 12 St Thomas St, Redcliffe, BS16JJ, Bristol, AU
- Phone number: +447779450111
- Network UUID: 4396b111-769c-46ac-99e4-43c85f132de3
- **Partner:** Toggle this setting to “Yes” to include this fleet in your job-sharing network, or leave it as “No” to exclude it.

Search and Filter:

- You can search fleets by name or filter by location using a radius (in kilometers).

4. Fleet Partnering Configuration

For each fleet listed, use the **Partner** toggle to decide whether to share jobs with that fleet:


- **No:** The default setting. This fleet will not receive jobs from your fleet.
- **Yes:** This fleet is part of your network and will receive jobs when shared.

5. Save Changes

After configuring your settings, ensure you save the changes to apply the networking configuration.

Note: It can take up to 15 minutes for the changes to take effect after saving.
